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BRIEF OVERVIEW

FMM Perak under the Chairmanship of En. Chua Kay Lin from Nutri Action Sdn Bhd continued to actively pursue with the State Government and Federal agencies on concerns and issues affecting members and in particular SMEs. The Branch championed the problems faced by members producing mineral based products with Perak Land and Mines Office (PTG Perak) such as the time period restriction ruling on transporting goods, export royalty and mining lease renewal. After strong lobbying, PTG Perak exempted twenty-one (21) members from the ruling on transporting mineral based products and provided reduction in export royalty charges for kaolin. In addition, the Branch also successfully urged Perak State Development Corporation (PKNP) to expedite the establishment of Centralised Labour Quarters in Perak and following this, Seri Iskandar and Silibin were earmarked as pilot projects which will be developed by CLQ Silvervalley Sdn Bhd.

On the increase in minimum wage, the Branch actively reiterated that it is not the right time due to the very challenging business conditions via Northern region engagement sessions with National Wage Consultative Council. To facilitated compliance to the Employees' Minimum Standards of Housing, Accommodations and Amenities Act, the Branch organised a series of webinars and engagement sessions with PLANMalaysia, Labour Department, BOMBA and Local Councils for the benefit of members in Perak.

The Branch continued to work closely with key government departments, namely Invest Perak, MIDA, MITI, and PKNP to address a wide range of issues faced by members. With the assistance from these agencies, the Branch was able to help members in their manufacturing license applications, secured funding for industrial profile signboards at Kamunting industrial areas, proposed infrastructure upgrading for FIZ Jelapang and provided a platform for trade opportunities during the working visit to Perak by Trade Delegation from Latin America and Caribbean countries. On utility related issues, the Branch worked closely with Tenaga Nasional Berhad Perak to address power interruptions, supply and power quality issues. Through the establishment of Industrial Park Management Committees (IPMC), members were able to actively participate to address perpetual infrastructure issues affecting industrial areas. Following Branch's representation at these IPMC meetings, road maintenance was carried out at Keramat Pulai Industrial Area, dredging of Sg. Lidin to overcome flooding at Jalan Air Kuning, Taiping, mitigation of the re-occurrence of flooding at Tungzen Industrial area and setting up of a WhatsApp group to raise maintenance issues of industrial areas within Ipoh.

Despite adverse effects of the Covid19 pandemic, the Branch continued to play a proactive role in updating members on the latest government policies and regulations by way of organising various programmes. For financial year 2021/2022, the Branch organised thirty-two (32) activities and co-organising the State level International Anti-Corruption Day 2021 with Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) at Branch Office was one of the pertinent one which was well received by members. To keep abreast with legislative updates, the Branch organised key Webinars namely on National Covid-19 Vaccination Programme, Latest Updates on Act 446 (Workers Accommodation), Amendments to the Employment Act, 1955 and Occupational Safety and Health (Amendment) Act which were well participated by members as well as non-members.

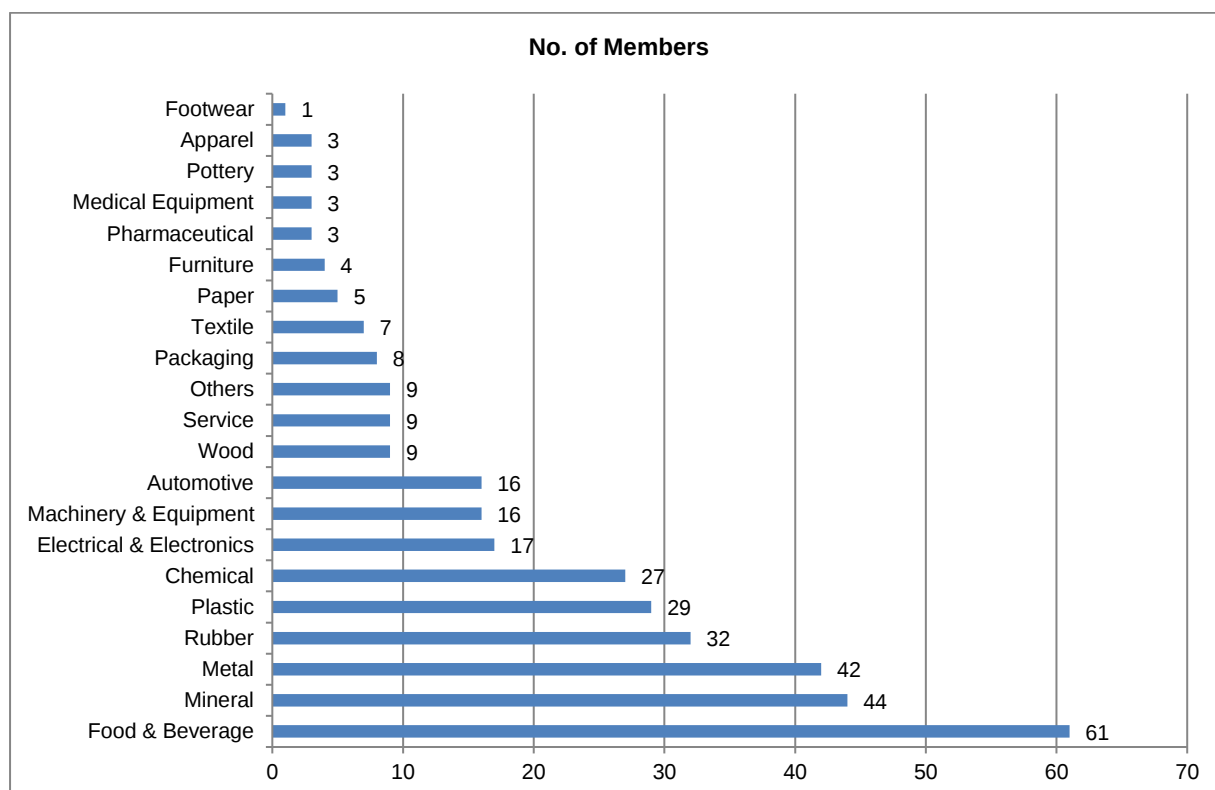

SIGNIFICANT DEVELOPMENT AND ISSUES

Assistance to Members

- Perak Land and Mines Office (PTG Perak) exempted twenty-one (21) members from the time period restriction ruling on transporting mineral based products following strong lobbying by the Branch.
- Secured significant reduction for 2021 export royalty on kaolin for two members after continuously representing the issue to PTG Perak.
- Assisted Noboru Packing Co and Gopeng Kalsium to apply for their manufacturing license with Malaysian Investment Development Authority (MIDA) Perak's help.
- Batang Padang District Health Department revoked its imposition on all manufacturers for mandatory Covid19 screening prior to resuming operations after the Branch raised the issue with the Director of Perak Health Department.
- Assisted Kaolin (M) Sdn Bhd to obtain approval for Mining Lease renewal for one lot for another ten years from PTG Perak.
- Actively reiterated that it is not the right time to increase the minimum wage due to the very challenging business conditions via Northern region engagement sessions with National Wage Consultative Council.
- Facilitated compliance to Act 446 (Workers Accommodation) by organising webinars and engagement sessions with PLANMalaysia, Labour Department, BOMBA and Local Councils.
- Branch urged the Perak State Development Corporation (PKNP) to expedite the establishment of Centralised Labour Quarters in Perak during the e-Meeting on October 12, 2021.
- Batu Gajah District Council (MDBG) will prepare a Survey Plan to mitigate the re-occurrence of flooding at the entrance to the Tungzen Industrial Area after Branch raised the issue at Batu Gajah IPMC meeting on April 6, 2022.
- The Department of Irrigation and Drainage (JPS) dredged Sungai Lidin in April, 2022 as a short-term plan to overcome flooding occurrence at Jalan Air Kuning affecting Chuan Sin Sdn Bhd following Branch's representation during the Taiping IPMC meeting in December, 2021.
- Branch to work closely with Telekom Malaysia (TM) to accelerate members' migration to Unifi services for better broadband coverage as agreed during TM Perak's courtesy visit on June 10, 2022.
- Organised Briefing cum Engagement Session on establishment of Centralised Labour Quarters (CLQ) in Perak on June 20, 2022 for the benefit of members in the vicinity of Seri Iskandar and Silibin which has been earmarked as pilot projects.
- Following proposal to Ipoh City Council, the Ipoh IPMC WhatsApp group was established in June, 2022 for members to raise infrastructure maintenance issues affecting industrial areas within Ipoh.

Infrastructure and Utilities

- FMM/TNB Committee meetings continued to serve as an effective platform for members to raise power quality issues and for TNB to keep members abreast with latest updates.



- Following Branch's representation on behalf of members at the Industrial Park Management Committees (IPMCs), infrastructure and maintenance issues were resolved at various local councils.
- Ipoh City Council and Taiping Municipal Council solved infrastructure maintenance issues at Tasek Industrial Area and Kamunting Industrial Area respectively following the Branch's intervention.
- Batu Gajah District Council (MDBG) undertook Keramat Pulai Industrial Area roads' maintenance costing RM1.4 million in April, 2022.
- Invest Perak approved allocation for the Industry profile signboards at Jalan Bulatan Tembaga Kuning Kamunting Raya and Bulatan Industri Kamunting.
- MIDA shortlisted FIZ Jelapang for RM2.4 million infrastructure upgrading allocation.

Trade and Business Facilitation

- Accelerated Covid19 vaccination for members' employees through the PIKAS immunisation programme after the Branch lobbied with MITI at the State and Federal level.
- Branch highlighted members' concerns on Covid19 SOP compliance, strict enforcement and closure of operations to YB State Exco for Industry and relevant State Government agencies during the e-Engagement session on July 28, 2021.
- Co-organised Seminar on "The Road Ahead with Industry4WRD" facilitated by MITI, MIDA MPC and SIRIM to brief members on policies, assessment, criteria and incentives.
- Assisted in providing supply chain requirements from overseas and local investors to members to increase business opportunities via various industrial linkage initiatives.
- Hosted delegation from the Republic of Azerbaijan and Uzbekistan to promote bilateral trade between Perak members and overseas business trade chambers.
- Members were provided a platform to secure trade opportunities during the Working Visit to Perak State by Trade Delegation from Latin America and Caribbean countries (GRULAC) on June 15, 2022.
- Received Canada Embassy Trade Officer to Branch on June 24, 2022 to discuss trade opportunities for Small and Medium Size Industries.

Corporate Social Responsibility

- Co-organised State level International Anti-Corruption Day 2021 with Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) at Branch Office on December 9, 2021.

FMM PERAK INSTITUTE REPORT

During the period under review, FMM Institute Perak organised 151 training programmes comprising 88 public courses, 59 in-house courses and 4 certificate courses which resulted in a total of 1,612 workers being trained. The increase in terms of number of programmes as against 2020/2021 was essentially due to post pandemic economy recovery. Face-to-face training programmes was allowed as well as online trainings which is still being favoured by companies to lower risk of physical contact.

Under the special project category, Institute successfully conducted 3 programmes, i.e.; Autodesk AutoCAD Essentials under KPT-Pace, Effective Supervisory Skills in collaboration with HRD Corp, Perak Branch and Executive Development Programme under Protégé.
