ISO 9001, the world's most widely adopted Quality Management System (QMS) standard, is being revised to remain relevant in today's rapidly changing business environment by addressing emerging challenges such as digital transformation, supply chain resilience, organizational agility, sustainability, cybersecurity, evolving stakeholder expectations, and global disruptions.

This one-day awareness programme equips participants with insights into the anticipated direction of ISO 9001:2026, the rationale behind the revision, and its expected impact on organizations, while exploring key business drivers, comparing current ISO 9001:2015 requirements with upcoming revision themes, and preparing QMS for a smooth transition. Practical guidance will also be provided on conducting a transition gap analysis, planning implementation activities, and developing an effective roadmap to minimize disruption and maintain certification readiness, based on the latest publicly available information, with final requirements to be confirmed upon official publication of ISO 9001:2026.

- Understand the ISO standard revision process and the expected publication and transition timeline for ISO 9001:2026.
- Explain the global business trends & organisational challenges driving the revision of ISO 9001.
- Identify the expected areas of change within ISO 9001:2026 and understand their potential impact on existing Quality Management Systems.
- Compare the current ISO 9001:2015 requirements with the anticipated direction of the revised standard.
- Develop an initial transition strategy and action plan to prepare their organization for implementation and certification.
