Overview

Bribery remains a major global risk, exposing organisations to legal, financial, operational and reputational consequences. The revised ISO 37001:2025 Anti-Bribery Management System provides enhanced requirements and practical controls to help organisations strengthen their anti-bribery framework. In Malaysia, Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) Act 2009 & Section 17A Corporate Liability reinforces the need for organisations to implement adequate procedures to prevent bribery and corruption. This 2-day Understanding and Implementing Training on ISO 37001:2025 provides practical knowledge of the standard, key implementation requirements and effective anti-bribery controls, supporting stronger compliance, governance, integrity and ethical business practices.
